

Foster Parent

Foster parents welcome SPCA animals (dogs, cats or rabbits) into their homes and provide a nurturing and comfortable environment for the animal to mature, heal or socialize. All foster parents must be Pinellas County residents and have transportation to pick up and drop off foster animals. Animals in your home must be spayed/neutered and up to date on vaccines (veterinary records must be made available). SPCA Tampa Bay asks that foster parents provide the basic essentials for foster animals, i.e. food, litter, toys, etc. All veterinary care and necessary medications will be provided by SPCA Tampa Bay.

Required Training: Foster orientation/tour (2 hours), reading of all materials provided regarding kitten and puppy care. Must be a Pinellas County resident.

Time Commitment: Most foster experiences are at least two weeks long, some can be upwards of 3-4 months.
