625 pets received loving care from our foster families.



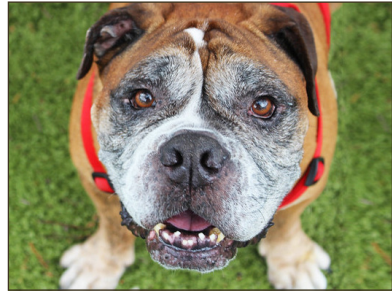
Transferred 1,017 animals to our facility to help relieve overcrowding at partner shelters.

102 team members on 2 campuses provided shelter and care for homeless, sick, injured, or baby animals of all kinds.

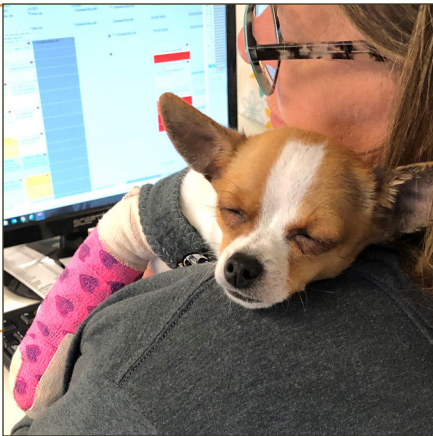


212 Diamond Dogs (7+ years old) received additional bloodwork to help best care for them.

593 walkers on 72 Pet Walk teams raised \$170,000 to support shelter programs.

3,174 households received assistance from our two Pet Food Banks, feeding more than 5,000 owned pets.



66 dogs treated for Heartworm.

The Day of Giving Fund Drive reached 1.9 million homes and brought in more than \$129,000 to care for homeless pets.
