YOU CAN BEQUEATH:

- The remainder or “residue” of your estate (what is remaining after your bequests are met)
- Your entire estate
- A percentage of your estate
- A specific dollar amount or specific assets
- A contingent bequest that passes to SPCA Tampa Bay in the event your primary beneficiary predeceases you.
